The **Golden-crowned Kinglet** likes to feed up in the trees, especially pines and evergreens.



Dark-eyed Juncos are usually found in small flocks searching for seeds on the ground.

Create your own bird feeder!

You can get a better look at some of these winter wanderers by setting up a bird feeder near a window.

- 1 Poke a stick through a plastic bottle and punch more holes for birds to reach the seeds.



- 2 Fill with bird seed and hang with string from a tree branch near your window. Now just wait for the birds to find it!
