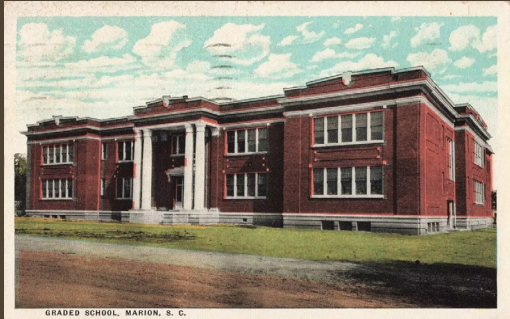


# THE HISTORY & LEGACY OF AMAZING GRACE PARK



**1912**

The Marion Graded School was built on these grounds in 1912 and opened in 1913 to the public.

**1976**

The school ran until 1976, and in 1977, it was demolished.

**2015**

On June 17, 2015, Nine lives were taken at Mother Emanuel Church in Charleston, South Carolina, including Reverend Senator Clementa Pinckney and Reverend Daniel Simmons, Sr., a native of Marion County.

**2020**

In honor of the lives lost, the Amazing Grace Park, The Clementa Pinckney Memorial was constructed in 2020 and opened in July of 2021 on Senator Pinckney's Birthday.

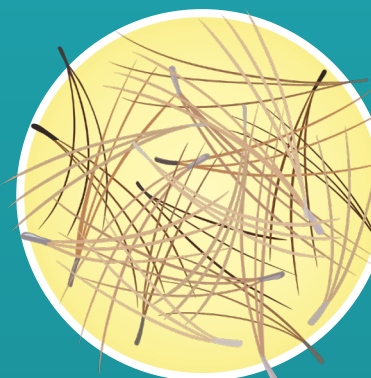

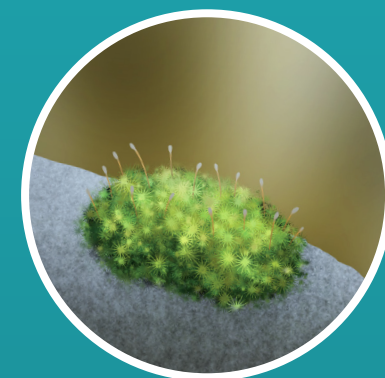
