

Do you know what is hiding in the dirt beneath your feet? Grab this brochure and head out on the trail to discover the wonders below the surface!


Soil Scatter


Put your scoop of soil on this brochure. Dig through and put the things you find in the box where they belong.

Put Scoop in this Box


Sticks



Rocks




