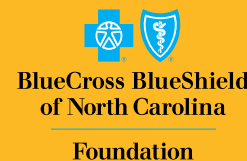

Oh, there he is. You're a good helper.



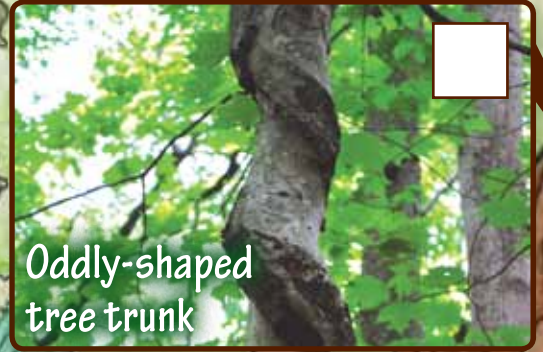
Now, let's find some other things hiding in nature. Just remember that all things in nature have a special place. Make sure you leave them here, so others can find them too!
